

**RESOLUTION No. 10-2013**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAK, WASHINGTON,  
APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
THE CITY OF OMAK AND FIRE DISTRICT NO. 3 FOR EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE  
SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, the Revised Code of Washington, RCW 35.39 authorizes units of government within the State to enter into cooperative agreements for the provision of goods and services to each other; and

**WHEREAS**, a Memorandum of Agreement with Fire District No. 3 was approved with Resolution 82-2009 on December 7, 2009, providing that the City mechanic will maintain the District's equipment stored in the Omak Fire Station; and

**WHEREAS**, this Amendment shall cover any equipment owned by the District, including equipment stationed outside of Omak; and


**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that the hourly rates previously charged to the District do not reflect the costs that include wages, benefits, City mechanic shop time, and re-stocking of miscellaneous mechanic consumables; and

**WHEREAS**, those costs have been determined to be \$65.00 per hour in 2013, effective January 1, 2013.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Omak that the Addendum to the Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Omak and Okanogan County Fire District No. 3, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", is hereby approved, and the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute and attest the agreement on behalf of the City.


