

RESOLUTION NO. 44-2017

**A RESOLUTION OF THE OMAK CITY COUNCIL APPROVING AN
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OMAK AND
OKANOGAN PUD**

WHEREAS, the Revised Code of Washington, RCW 39.34 authorizes units of government within the State to enter into cooperative agreements for the provision of goods and services to each other; and

WHEREAS, the Okanogan PUD provides for the maintenance, repair and operation of the Omak street lighting by agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) has provided the City of Omak and other participating agencies a grant for the conversion of existing street lighting to LED technology; and


WHEREAS, Okanogan PUD has the experience and expertise to execute this project on behalf of the participating agencies; and

WHEREAS, this interlocal agreement is an efficient use of public money and resources.




